## A. ADMIN MATTERS

### 1. Arrangements for 2018 School Hours

The school hours for 2018 are from **8 am to 1.45 pm from Monday to Friday.**

We encourage all pupils to be on time for school. All pupils must attend flag raising ceremony at 8am on school days. We have arranged the following pre-assembly activities which start at 7.40 am daily to engage the pupils who arrive early in school and all pupils are to be at their respective assembly venue by 8.00 am every morning, as follows:

For activities after school hours, such as Supplementary and Remedial lessons, Learning Support Programmes, Enrichment Programmes, CCAs and so on, pupils are to assemble at the Hall after their lunch. Teachers / Instructors will take them from the Hall to the respective venues for the programmes / activities.

### 2. Meet- the-Parents Session (MTP) P2 – P6

We would like to invite all P2 to P6 parents to join us at our Meet-The-Parents session on **Friday, 12 January 2018 from 8 am to 9 am.** The respective Form Teachers from the classes will be briefing parents on the programmes, expectations for each subject area, curriculum and assessment matters and carry out a class dialogue session with parents. As this is only an hour session, we hope to see you during the session. If you have further queries, you can contact the Form Teachers via their emails.

We will also be asking parents to update your child's particulars on that day for Primary 2 to Primary 6 parents. The form will be issued by the Form Teacher on Friday, 12 January 2018. Parents who are not able to attend will be given the form to fill. Please kindly return the form by Friday, 19 January 2018.

### 3. Safety of our Pupils and Traffic flow

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils, staff and stakeholders are of utmost importance and we seek the cooperation and support of all pedestrians, drivers/motorists entering our school compound to observe Safety for self and others especially during Arrival and Dismissal times. We seek your understanding and cooperation to adhere to the directions and advice given for better traffic management for the safety of all users.

### 4. Bookshop Revised Opening Hours

Textbooks, stationery, school uniforms and PE attire are available at the school bookshop. The bookshop is open from 8:30am to 3:00pm from Mondays to Fridays during the school term except on Wednesdays from 8:30am to 3:30pm. The bookshop is closed for lunch from 1:00pm to 1:40pm.

## **B. PUPIL MATTERS**

### **1. Virtue of Responsibility**

We have been teaching our girls to exercise the virtue of responsibility and self-discipline in looking after their things. We encourage parents to assist us in helping your girls to learn that they have to bring their own things to school. Thus, if your child / ward has called you to help bring their things to school, please refrain from bringing for them.

We also would like you to note that pupils are not allowed to call their parents / guardians during curriculum time. Calls can only be made during recesses or after school. We would also like to encourage parents / guardians from calling the General Office to pass message to your child / ward, unless very urgent matters.

### **2. 2018 HOMEWORK POLICY**

Homework policy aims to help pupils establish a healthy balance between commitments in school, after school and at home. This would also strengthen the home-school links by reaffirming the role parents and care-givers play as partners in education.

#### **GENERAL GUIDELINES ON DAILY HOMEWORK**

The school seeks to ensure pupils' wellness by not overloading pupils with homework assignments. It adopts the following guidelines to manage the workload of pupils. The school and teachers have worked out an estimated amount of time that pupils would spend to complete their homework assignments daily.

<b>Level</b>	<b>Estimated Time Spent on Homework Daily</b>
P1	30 minutes (emphasis on reading)
P2	30 minutes to 1 hour
P3	1 hour to 1 hour 30 minutes
P4	1 hour to 1 hour 30 minutes
P5	1 hour 30 minutes to 2 hours
P6	1 hour 30 minutes to 2 hours

Pupils who are not able to finish the work set in class will also need to complete it at home. In addition, pupils may be tasked to read some materials or write a journal at home. This should not be more than twice a week.

### **3. Well-Being of Pupils and Staff**

We encourage all pupils and staff to maintain a high standard of personal hygiene and wash their hands with diligence. We would like to remind parents that if pupils are unwell and showing flu-like symptoms, they should see a doctor and come to school when they are certified fit by the doctor.

### **4. Anti-Idling Engine Regulations**

Based on the media advisory released by NEA, parents who are waiting to pick their children from school need to switch off the engines of the car while waiting to pick your daughter from school. Through collective efforts by school and NEA, we hope that in the new year, parents will continue to comply with the anti-idling engine regulations. Let us continue to work together to safeguard the public health for our pupils and our loved ones.

### **5. Temperature Taking on Friday, 5 January 2018**

As part of the measures to maintain schools' preparedness to resume temperature-taking regime, as well as to ensure that all new students are familiar with temperature-taking, there will be a temperature-taking exercise conducted on **Friday 5 January 2018** by the school. In preparation for the exercise, we will be conducting a pre-exercise check on Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) on **Wednesday & Thursday, 3 & 4 January 2018**.

We would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child brings her personal ODT on the two days mentioned. ALL P1 students and International students new to the school will be issued their first ODT FREE. All the other students should purchase a new ODT from the pharmacies, NTUC or school bookshop if their ODTs are missing or are no longer working.

## 6. Birthday Party

We would like to remind parents who want to celebrate their girls' birthdays with their classmates to only bring a birthday cake and to refrain from providing extra food e.g. fast food meal sets with toys, deep fried food etc. Kindly refrain from giving goodie bags of any items edible or non-edible. Please note that there will be no birthday celebrations during assessment weeks and kindly contact the Form Teacher at least 3 days in advance. We sincerely appreciate your kind understanding on this.

## C. CURRICULAR & CO-CURRICULAR MATTERS

### 1. IJ Young Lady Programme

The IJ Young Lady Programme, which was introduced two years ago to our P1 to P6 pupils, had helped them to become gracious citizens of tomorrow. This year, P1 and P2 pupils will be attending social etiquette classes conducted by their Form Teachers during curriculum hours. P3 to P6 pupils will be attending social etiquette classes as a post exam activity. After going through a 6-year module of IJ Young Lady Programme, we hope CHIJ OLQP pupils will become young ladies, equipped with social etiquette that will help them develop their social confidence and personal style.

### 2. Religious Education / Catechism Classes (for Catholic pupils)

As in the past years, the school will be conducting catechism classes for Catholic pupils in all levels with the help of the Sr Joan, church volunteers and teachers. These lessons are aimed at helping pupils live the gospel values in their daily lives. Parents are reminded that Catholic pupils will need to attend Catechism classes in their respective parishes, as the programme in the parishes specifically prepares children for the sacraments.

### 3. PAL for P1 & P2

PAL stands for Programme for Active Learning. It consists of modules of activities in the 4 domains, Sports & Games and Outdoor Education, Performing Arts (Music and Dance) and Visual Arts, which are carried out within the curriculum for all Primary 1 and 2 pupils.

**4. PERI Holistic Assessment (HA) Primary 1 and 2**

In CHIJ OLQP, we believe that assessment is an important aspect of teaching and learning and it should be used to support the holistic development of our pupils. At Primary 1 and Primary 2, when the child is just beginning school, a key focus should be on building her confidence and desire to learn. Thus, our assessments would be focusing more on providing information on the learning progress of the child. Teachers will use a range of assessment tools, including written and performance tasks to provide feedback to pupils on their mastery of concepts and skills as well as their strengths and areas for improvement.

Our assessment practices will move beyond summative evaluation which tends to measure achievement in narrowly defined domains towards holistic assessment. In this respect, the assessments for your child will not take the form of examinations but alternative modes of assessment. These assessments will contribute to her grades and they will be conducted throughout the year. Further details of the assessments will be given to you at a later date.

**5. SWIMSAFER National Swimming and Water Safety Programme for Primary 3, 2018**

For the fifth year, the school will be implementing the **SwimSafer Programme at the Senja-Cashew Swimming Complex** during school hours on Mondays and Fridays, for eight 1h 30 min sessions, as part of our PE programme.

The objective of this programme is to teach basic swimming skills and knowledge of aquatic safety to enable pupils to be aware of safety in an aquatic environment. The coach to pupil ratio is **1:10**. This 8-session programme is fully subsidised and it includes test fee and the admission charges to the swimming complex for your child. Your child will receive a certificate upon completion of the programme.

**6. CCA and Remedial and Supplementary Lessons**

CCA Sessions will begin on the **second week of Term 1 (Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> January 2018)**. More information to the girls concerned will be sent out in due course.

Supplementary lessons for Primary 5 and 6 and Remedial lessons for Primary 3 and 4 will begin on the **third week of Term 1 (Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018)**. More information will be given to you via the Assistant Year Head in due time.

The objective of the I-Drive programme is to enhance cognitive development of our pupils with increasing complexity of process skills and to complement pupils' development in linguistics ability and ICT skills. This programme will be carried out in Semester 1 where pupils will be mentored by teachers for their I-DRIVE project.
