

## Overseas Learning Programme (I-GIVE) 2014

Our **I-GIVE** (*I Give Genuinely, Intelligently, Vibrantly and Emotionally*) programme aims to provide pupils with opportunities to practise in real life what they learnt in school. We also aim to provide each child with at least one opportunity to go on an overseas learning journey (OLJ) when they are with us. This year, pupils will be travelling to places like Japan, Suzhou, Penang, Sydney and Taiwan.

### P5 IJ Heritage OLJ to Japan

Earlier in June this year, four of our teachers led a group of 26 primary 5 pupils to Tokyo and Yokohama as part of the P5 IJ Heritage Overseas Learning Journey to Japan. Pupils had opportunities to visit our IJ sister schools: 2 in Tokyo and 2 in Yokohama. Our pupils had lessons with the pupils there and immerse in their culture. They also learnt a bit about the culture of the IJ schools there and visited Mother Mathilde's resting place. Pupils also learnt about environmental issues in Japan and they visited a few science and technology centres. Pupils even get to bring home their own cup noodles from the cup noodle museum! They thoroughly enjoyed themselves.
