Project Objectives

- ♥ Support the school's fundraising effort

Project Timeline

12 January

- Students were given Letter to Parents explaining the project objectives.

**13 January
0800-0900**

- Mr Lim presents project and its objectives to the pupils.

20 January

- Students, Staff and Partners receive donation card.

Weeks**

- Students collect donations from parents/relatives to support the project and fill up the donation card.

**13 February
to 24 March**

- Students are guided to fold origami paper into cranes during Art / FTGP. Students submit folded cranes to Form teacher.

**17 February
FTGP**

- Form Teachers collect money and donation card from students.

3 April

- Form Teachers return pledge cards to students. Parents can view photographs of their daughters with their paper cranes showcased online. Parents pledge an amount and write affirmative words on the pledge card.

10 April

- Students bring back pledge cards and pledge amount to submit to Form teacher.

14 April

- Folded cranes will be collected and put together into art pieces.

25 May

Founders' Day
Celebration

- School Leaders and Committee announce the final collection.
- Project is wrapped up.
